Tie Breaking Calculator

Tie Breaking for Qualifiers, Play Off Positioning and Seeding is determined as follows, in order:

- 1 Overall record
- 2 Head to Head*
- 3 Opponent Wins
- 4 Playoff points

* In cases of a tie with three or more teams, all teams must have played each other.

Bracket/Class Ranking Calculation Two Tier Calculator System

Each Tier will rank all of the Qualifiers with an overall position based on the number of Qualifiers (ie..1-36)

Once each Tier Ranking is calculated, both Tiers Rankings are combined for one overall Playoff Ranking.

Tie Breaking Calculator is used for both Tiers, when needed.

Tier One

Helmet Count Multiplier Calculation (Old School)

(Total Wins)-(Total Losses)+(Helmet Count) = Tier 1 Ranking*

*Highest Qualifier has a "Tier 1 Ranking" of 1, Lowest has the Lowest
"Tier 1 Ranking" of 36.

Tier Two

Opponent Wins Multiplier Calculation (New School)

(Total Wins)-(Total Losses)+(Opponent Wins*) = Tier 2 Ranking*

*BYE teams add equal to their wins

*Highest Qualifier has a "Tier 2 Ranking" of 1, Lowest has the Lowest "Tier 2 Ranking" of 36.

PREMIER TEAMS CAN ONLY BE IN TOP 2 BRACKETS

Tier 1 Ranking and Tier 2 Ranking are combined for an Overall Playoff Ranking ("OPR") (ie..1 through 36)

Tie Breaking Calculator is used in determining OPR, when necessary.

Once the OPR has been determined, the Qualifiers will be divided into Play Off Groupings of six (6) teams, in order of OPR as follows:

5A* 6 Qualifiers with the Lowest OPR
4A Next 6 Lowest OPR Qualifiers
3A Next 6 Lowest OPR Qualifiers
2A Next 6 Lowest OPR Qualifiers
1A Next 6 Lowest OPR Qualifiers

*5A is the Highest/Best Qualifier Class When 30 Teams Qualify

U TEAMS CAN ONLY BE IN BOTTOM BRACKET

Tie Breaking Calculator is used in determining seeding with each bracket once bracketed teams have been established via the OPR.
